Infant & Toddler Program _____

The concepts of early brain stimulation and early attachment theory are the corner stones of the Carol Matheys infant and toddler program. This program offers a unique approach to care for children ages 6 weeks to 36 months. It includes age appropriate developmental activities with primary care givers. This gives your baby a nurturing environment and lots of fun. Our infant / toddler program is called Treasured Tykes and is located at North Presbyterian Church in North St. Paul.



Preschool Programs _____

We offer full-day preschool and Half Day Preschool Programs for 3-5 year olds. Both programs use a developmentally appropriate curriculum that promotes a pro-social environment. Children learn through creative play, music, crafts, science, computers and games. We offer nutritionally-balanced meals and snacks and participate in the USDA child nutrition program. Our programs offer full- and part-time schedules to accommodate a variety of work schedules.

School Age Program _____

We provide children grades Kindergarten - 5th grade a fun and safe place to be before and after school. Children enjoy crafts, games, computers, outdoors, and being with their friends in a fun supervised environment. On non-school days and during the summer we offer full day programs. We serve Cowern, Castle and St. Peters Elementary Schools.

Family Programs _____

The focus in our family programs is to provide support, learning, and encouragement to children and their parents. We offer a variety of programming throughout the year to support families. Some of these activities include Family Learn and Play, special-topic classes ,parenting groups, a single parent support group and family field trips. These are part of a larger program of family advocacy and good communication which we see as vital to successful programming for children.
